Multi-Vendor Shipping



SHIPPER CHALLENGE

Con Edison faced a massive logistics challenge coordinating shipments from multiple vendors across the U.S., Mexico and Canada — in some cases shipments went from vendor-to-vendor before arriving in New York. With tight deadlines and last-minute changes in origin points, they needed a reliable partner to manage complex, timesensitive transportation demands.

WWEX Group took full ownership of the project's logistics – handling LTL, TL, air, cross-border shipping, warehousing and other solutions. They streamlined vendor coordination, managed costs, organized collaboration and quickly adapted to shifting requirements, ensuring 5 million+ meters were delivered safely, on time and within budget.

We calculated that if you lined up all the 53-foot trailers GlobalTranz supplied for this project, they would have stretched out over 17 miles. 30+ Days to 12: Border Clearance Time Reduced

Mexico-U.S. Customs Compliance



SHIPPER CHALLENGE

Con Edison's project faced major customs hurdles when a New Hampshire vendor unexpectedly shifted production to Mexico. Without a customs broker or cross-border process in place, delays at the Texas-Mexico border crossing caused clearance times of 30+ days – putting critical project deadlines at risk

WWEX Group swiftly connected Con Edison with a trusted customs broker, coordinated with vendors and streamlined compliance processes. They reduced clearance times from 30+ days to just 12, managing tariffs, billing and the broker — ensuring seamless cross-border operations without disrupting project timelines.

CHALLENGE 3

Warehousing



SHIPPER CHALLENGE

Con Edison ran out of warehouse space in New York and New Jersey during a critical phase of the project. They needed a fast solution to store over 20,000 meters for 4-5 months near their operations. But what started as a shortterm need quickly became a long-term challenge.
