Arizona Public Service Overview

Arizona Public Service (APS) has nearly 6,000 employees and provides reliable, affordable and increasingly clean energy to more than 1.3 million homes and businesses in 11 of Arizona's 15 counties. According to its website, the APS territory "stretches across the state, from the border town of Douglas to the vistas of the Grand Canyon, from the solar fields of Gila Bend to the ponderosa pines of Payson."

With warehouses, power plants, offices and substations located throughout Arizona, APS relies heavily on shipping to move everything from "pencils all the way up to turbines." The energy company has worked with GlobalTranz for 15 years and has entrusted the third-party logistics (3PL) provider to assist with its shipping needs.

In fact, Brandon Baker, a category manager at APS, said GlobalTranz has visited many of the power plants APS owns and made it a mission to understand the intricacies of their business and operations.

"GlobalTranz consistently makes shipping more efficient and easier for us," Baker said.

Challenge 1 // Inefficient Mode Selection

SHIPPER CHALLENGE

APS currently utilizes LTL and FTL freight shipping. However, there wasn't always a process in place that would help them select the right service for the right shipment.

GLOBALTRANZ SOLUTION

GlobalTranz and APS, working as partners, have created a process where internal buyers confirm that FTL services are completely essential — particularly if they are time sensitive and need door-to-door service or if they are fragile and need the entire truck. Otherwise, APS will utilize the GlobalTranz network of LTL freight carriers, which is a more cost-effective option.

"Mode selection has provided massive savings. We have cost saving goals in our contract with GlobalTranz and with mode selection alone they typically meet that number."





Challenge 2 // Power Outages

SHIPPER CHALLENGE

Like most power companies, APS performs planned outages so maintenance can be performed at their power plants, but also occasionally experiences unplanned outages. In both scenarios, APS has tight deadlines to perform necessary tasks and restore power. This requires them to utilize expedited shipping for crucial parts and equipment.

GLOBALTRANZ SOLUTION

GlobalTranz works closely with APS during outages, offering expertise and shipping solutions that ensure delivery of shipments. In fact, during a recent unplanned outage, GlobalTranz located and offered a chartered jet that could deliver a critical part from across the country in a matter of hours. APS ended up not needing the service, but the exercise illustrates that GlobalTranz is willing to explore all options to meet the critical needs of its customers.

"All of the people on our side were personally feeling the urgency during this situation. In the end, we didn't need the part or the jet, but the experience was good and now we know we have an extreme expedited solution through GlobalTranz."





Challenge 3 // Pricing

SHIPPER CHALLENGE

Fluctuating freight shipping costs make it difficult to plan for logistics spending. This was a particularly sensitive issue since APS, due to business requirements, tends to ship with premium carriers who charge more for their services. However, the company found itself going with the cheaper, but not necessarily better, carriers to combat increased rates.

GLOBALTRANZ SOLUTION

Working with GlobalTranz, APS now has contract shipping rates with top-tier LTL and FTL carriers for 30 of their most used lanes. The tactic has helped control costs without diminishing the service level needed to maintain the reliability customers expect.

Accountability Through KPI Metrics

GlobalTranz and APS thought it was important to create checks and balances to ensure the shipping service level was maintained. Working as partners, the two companies developed a strategic KPI structure that would point to successes and failures. According to APS, GlobalTranz always meets the agreed-upon KPIs, including:

PRICING ACCURACY

Less than 1% of invoices contain overcharges in any quarterly period.

ON-TIME DELIVERY

Less than 5% of shipments are delivered after their scheduled delivery date each quarter.

EFFICIENCY GAINS AND COST SAVINGS

Cost saving program aimed at saving up to \$300,000.


